

Saturday, August 6, 2011 - Seekonk Speedway

Austin Brehio Racing went down to Seekonk Speedway this weekend for the PASS race. This was an interesting and challenging track for Austin, as he had never driven on a track like this before. Seekonk has constant turning, which was a good test of Austin's strength and ability to drive this pro stock. He proved that he could do it by finishing the race!

When we first arrived at the track, Austin walked the track with his Dad to figure out the line. He then had two short and one long practice session to try to figure out how to drive it.

He opted to start the rear in his heat and he kept up with the field, but didn't pass anyone.

For the feature, he started 23rd out of 26 cars. Early on in the race, while he was still learning how to get around this new track, he was lapped twice. However, as he became more comfortable, he began to drive harder and keep up with the drivers in front of him. He avoided several accidents in front of him and just kept getting better with each lap. Over the rest of the 150 lap race, he was only lapped two more times. He completed 146 out of 150 laps and finished in 17th. We are very proud of him for finishing his 2nd PASS race!
