

Saturday, September 24, 2011 – White Mountain Motorsports Park

Austin Brehio Racing went back up to White Mountain Motorsports Park for our last PASS event of the season this past weekend. It was a beautiful time of year to back up in the mountains and see the foliage starting to turn.

We had three practice sessions. The first one, Austin felt the car was pretty good, but a little loose. Then for the second practice, the car got a little too tight and was pushing. For the third session, we only spent about 10 laps on the track and scuffed new tires and the car felt “great”.

This was the first PASS event that Austin was going to have to truly “qualify” for because 28 cars showed up for 26 spots. Unfortunately, he had his worst “draw” of the season, pulling number 46! This means that he had to start in 7th in the 3rd heat. Right on the start, the outside lane got the jump, which resulted in Austin shuffling to the rear. He did a great job keeping up with the pack and trying to set-up a sling-shot move to get around the 92. However, he just didn’t have enough horsepower to get by him coming out of the turn and down the straightaway. Therefore, he finished in 9th and had to start the Consi in 9th place, out of 10 cars. He ended up finishing 9th right on the bumper of the #2 car. So....he didn’t make the feature. This was very disappointing for the team and Austin, but at least the car was handling great and he was keeping right up with the pack!
